

# LONDON CHECKLIST

## CLOTHING

Remember London is hot during the summer with temperatures in the upper 80s/90s with little to no rain

- COMFORTABLE** walking shoes
- t-shirts, tops for 6 weeks
- shorts, light fabrics, wraps
- 1 business formal outfit (men: suit and tie; women: dress or suit)
- Rain jacket
- Laundry bags
- Optional: running / exercise clothes (Moonraker has a gym available with a nominal fee)

## TOILETRIES

Moonraker provides toilet paper, towels, sheets, and pillows

- Toothbrush
- Razor
- Face wipes
- Makeup
- Deodorant
- Body spray / perfume
- Travel sized sunscreen
- Moisturizer
- Hairbrush / Comb

## THE BIG STUFF

- Passport and ID (make copies and keep them in your bag)
- A copy of your King's College acceptance (you will need this to get a study visa)
- Your reading for the courses
- A map of the tube (digital and paper)
- \$100 in cash (Make sure to get it at your bank in the U.S. and not the airport tellers. Your U.S. Bank will convert the money for you without charging a large transaction fee)
- Outlet converters for the U.K.
- Laptop for class
- Pen and notebook for class (It is easier to bring from U.S. than try to find an office supply store in London)
- Notify your bank about travel plans to the U.K. so you don't get locked out of your account
- Optional: a U.K. SIM card or unlocked phone service (If you get a U.K. SIM, you need to let UNC ITS know your new credentials so that you can continue to use Heelmail two-step verification)

## Misc.

- Camera (memory cards, spare batteries)
- Reusable water bottle
- Umbrella
- Sunglasses
- Entertainment (books, cards, etc.)
- Optional: small portable fan (most of London does not have AC, including the British Museum)
